No transaction fee on cash sales. £1 transaction fee on credit and debit card sales where the total spend is over £15.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT: Park Street is served by frequent bus services (1, 8, 9, 40, 41, 54, U5, U6). Visit firstgroup.com for details of the best bus for your journey. The nearest bus stops **B** are located at Queens Road and College Green.

PARKING: On-street parking is metered (Mon-Sat £2.50 after 6pm, Sun no charge).
