### Timothy Mitchell, clarinet

Timothy is currently 15 years old and attends Castle School in Thornbury. A musical child from a very young age, Timothy first started playing the piano aged 7, then the clarinet aged 9. His progress on the clarinet was phenomenal from the start, passing Grade 3 with distinction after just eight monthly lessons, and later attaining a high distinction at Grade 8. Timothy was Principal Clarinet of the National Children's Orchestra from 2015 to 2018, and is currently part of the National Youth Orchestra's 'Inspire' programme for young musicians with great potential. More locally, as well as winning prizes in many competitions and eisteddfods, Timothy was the South Cotswold Rotary Young Musician on the Year 2018 and represented the South West at National Semi-final level. He is currently competing in the BBC Young Musician 2021 competition rounds.

Last year Timothy began lessons with internationally renowned clarinettist Robert Plane, in addition to his local lessons with David Pagett. The Tom Eveson Bursary award will help with the cost of these lessons.
